ABSTRACT

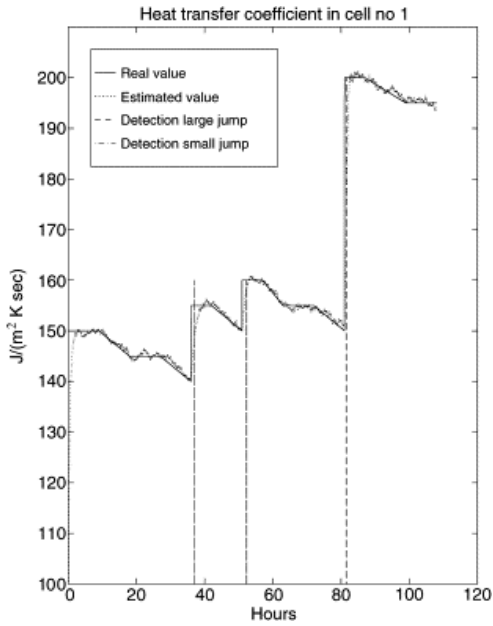
